



Quick Facts

Located in Little Rock, Arkansas: the political, cultural, and economic capitol of the state, as well as the geographic center with a regional area population of approximately 1,000,000

The Town Center is the 400,000 square foot retail and restaurant component of the 4,000,000 SF mixed-use development at the intersection of I-430 and Cantrell Road

Located on Cantrell Road (45,000 cars per day) and just west of I-430(75,000 cars per day) with three traffic signals from Cantrell Road into the center

Anchors: Parisian and The Fresh Market

Designed by CMH Architects: same architects that designed the Avenue projects in Atlanta

The Town Center has its own U.S. Postal Office and a City of Little Rock Fire Station

Adjacent to Pleasant Valley Country Club and less than 10 minutes from 7 other country clubs including The Alotian Club on Cantrell Road/Hwy 10 which was named America's Best New Private Course of 2005 by Golf Digest, and was ranked No. 3 on the magazine's list of America's 50 Greatest Golf Retreats

Neighbor to Little Rock Athletic Club: 10,000 members with 40,000 visits per month

Minutes away from the new "Big Dam Bridge" which is the longest biking/walking bridge in the world
